M209- A MAJOR MILESTONE: TAQA TRANSMISSION AWARDS NEW PIPELINE PROJECT

We are pleased to announce the successful award of a major project by TAQA Transmission, marking a significant milestone as our first pipeline project awarded by TAQA Transmission.

Contract No. N-18349 – Replacement of DN1000 mm Pipeline from Shobaisi to Remah Pump Station

The project encompasses the design, supply, installation, testing, and commissioning of a DN1000 Carbon Steel (CS) pipeline spanning approximately 55 km, along with DN150–DN400 Ductile Iron (DI) pipelines covering approximately 2.3 km, extending from Shobaisi Pumping Station to Maqam along the Abu Dhabi–Al Ain Road. The project is scheduled for completion within a 30-month duration.

In addition to the pipeline works, the scope includes the replacement/new installation of surge vessels and associated air compressors at both Shobaisi Pumping Station and Remah Pumping Station. The project also covers the design, supply, and installation of field instrumentation, together with the associated Electrical & Instrumentation (E&I) works and system integration, delivering a comprehensive and fully integrated solution.

This project represents a significant milestone in our growing relationship with TAQA Transmission and further strengthens our portfolio of major water transmission infrastructure projects.
